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MEDICAL ENGLISH: FEATURES AND LEARNING STRATEGIES Medical practice: communications in languages

- In clinic practice, communication via languages places the most priority
 - Between doctors and patients
 - Between doctors and public
 - Between doctors and their colleagues

MEDICAL ENGLISH: FEATURES AND LEARNING STRATEGIES Learning Medical English in medical science learning settings

 Language is not merely a kind of knowledge---the application and practice are more important for adult learners



- Personal reasons: settings, interests, motivations
 - Cognitive reasons: logical instead of figurative practical in stead of imitative
- Professional reasons: career development (pressure, peer influence)



Utilizing English is the best policy as

- Learning medical English in medical curricular settings
 Terminology and symbols in the medical collocations
 Reading of medical literature and documents with certain task or pressure
 - Medical oral communication skills in real situation or in clinic
 - Medical practical writing for reals demand or situations
 - Medical academic writing for dissertation or research purposes

- Language practice and application

Positive/active learning: task-oriented unit study

Reading of Various Medical Materials

- Read medical textbooks-- this is the major activity in our course conduction
- Reading practical (applied) medical material (manual, clinical documents etc.)
- Reading medical literature (nonfictional, medical column and news articles)
- Reading medical research papers

Medical Science Writing

- Academic writing may include:
 - literature review on research program
 abstracts for research paper
 - short paper or case report in clinical research

Teaching and Learning Methods

- Language teachers will focus on language structures and learning strategies, intending to guide learning tasks from language point of view
- Learners study the materials from medical perspective , and try to interpret and apprehend their familiar medical materials from linguistic point of view
- The discussions between the teacher and learners would reinforce the learners' understanding of the material with multi-angle interpretation
